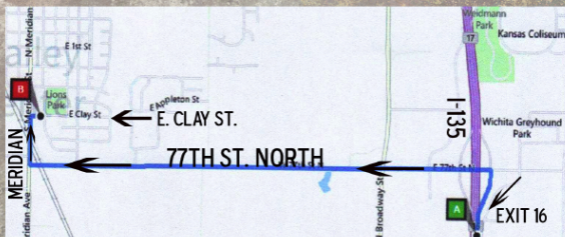

THE MOVING WALL

“The Moving Wall” is the original half-size replica of the Washington, DC Vietnam Veterans Memorial and has been touring the country for more than twenty years. The granite replica stands 252.83 feet long and is inscribed with the names of more than 58,000 Americans who died or are missing in Vietnam.

The traveling monument has been displayed in cities across the country, allowing millions of visitors to experience the memorial.

Free and open to the public 24 hours a day, The Moving Wall is dedicated to the veterans of the Vietnam War and honors all U.S. servicemen and women.
