- 6 months left to host your remaining Commemorative Events with our support (March 31)!

If you plan on hosting any events over the next six months, and desire <u>materials or support</u>, *submit your event requests* (DD2956) through the <u>Commemorative Partner Portal</u> as soon as possible. Our staffing is limited, and we will be assessing and assigning support capabilities on a *first-come*, *first-serve* basis.

This season of the year we also honor our *Hispanic Americans*. National Hispanic Heritage Month extends from *September 15* to *October 15*, and is the only Department of Defense *special observance* to span multiple months. During this period, we recognize individuals who have sacrificed for, contributed to and served our country. This year, we highlight Vietnam War Medal of Honor Recipient, retired U.S. Army Master Sergeant, <u>Roy P. Benavidez</u>. Above and beyond his valorous actions that earned him the <u>Medal of Honor</u>, he also received the Purple Heart, and multiple other awards over his career. Until his death in 1998, Benavidez *mentored* underprivileged children, and *successfully advocated* for continued benefits for disabled Vietnam veterans. In addition, <u>USNS *Benavidez*</u> (T-AKR-306) was christened in his honor in 2001 by the United States Navy.
